# Definition: SECTOR (Noun)

- ▶ 1. an area or portion that is distinct from others.
- ▶ a distinct part or branch of a nation's economy or society or of a sphere of activity such as education.
- ▶ MILITARY
- ▶ a subdivision of an area for military operations.
- ▶ COMPUTING
- ▶ a subdivision of a track on a magnetic disk.
- ▶ 2. the plane figure enclosed by two radii of a circle or ellipse and the arc between them.
- ▶ 3. a mathematical instrument consisting of two arms hinged at one end and marked with sines, tangents, etc. for making diagrams.

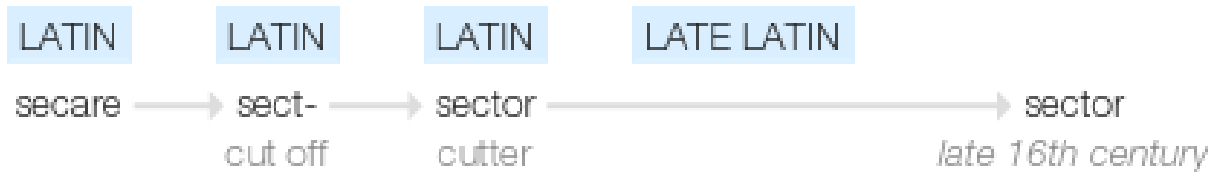

# Etymology: SECTOR

- ▶ The etymology (history/origin) of SECTOR is:



- ▶ late 16th century (in sector (sense 2, sense 3)): from late Latin, a technical use of Latin *sector* 'cutter', from *sect-* 'cut off', from the verb *secare* .
