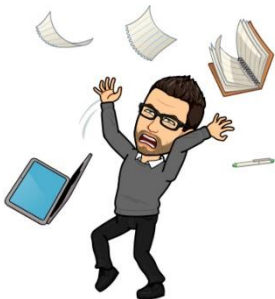


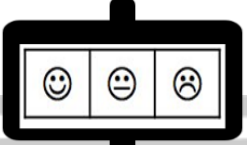

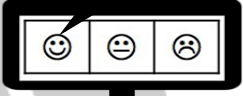


What are the Gothic Conventions?

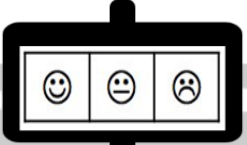
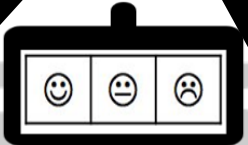

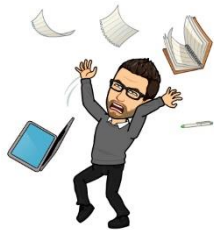

Task: Begin a word bank of key creative writing terms and definitions. Add to it as you work through the lessons.

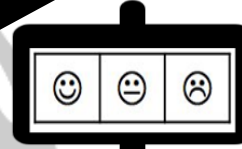


Responding to an image stimulus.

Task: What are the differences between descriptive and narrative writing?



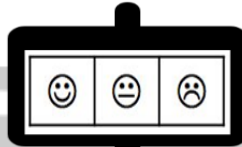
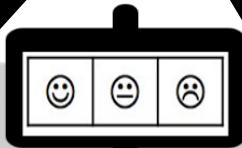
Developing character
